
Our Guidelines & Practices: What we play...

- Official Men's Club weekly events are held on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays from April 1 through October 31
 - Mondays Skins Game
 - Wednesdays Individual and 2 or 4-man Team games
 - Fridays 4-man Team games with teams determined by a "blind" ball-drop
- To accommodate seasonal weather condition changes, first starting T-times are:
 - April 10:00am
 - May 9:00am
 - June thru August 8:30am
 - September 9:00am
 - October 10:00am
- Entry Fees & Payouts
 - Monday Skins: \$5 to play Gross, or Net Only;
 \$10 to play bothcash payout to winners at conclusion of play
 - Wednesday games: \$10 entry paid to course;
 players will be put into be two groups Flight A:
 0-12 hcp., Flight B: 13+
 - Payouts will be to lowest Net scores and be clubhouse credits
 - Friday games: \$5 entry/player; cash payout to winning team
- Lost Tracks Cup (LTC) for all Wednesday games, LTC Points are awarded for players finishing: 1st (100pts.), 2nd (65pts.), and 3rd (35pts.) place both in Gross and Net for individual and team games. All other players will receive 10pts for participating
- If a member has a guest who would like to play in any of the weekly games, the member must get approval from the Executive Board
- Sign-Ups for all weekly Men's Club games must be done 24-hours prior to the day of play
- The official calendar for Wednesday games will be provided to all Members prior to start of the season and updated as needed

Our Guidelines & Practices: How we play...

- Rules of Play All members are expected to abide by the Rules of Golf as set forth by USGA/OGA
- Oversight of the rules is provided by the Lost Tracks Golf Club officials, the Men's Club Executive Board and its Handicap Chair, and the Rules & Course Conditions Committee.
- Lost Tracks Golf Club officials will determine and communicate changes in play due to weather conditions.
- The Rules & Course Conditions Committee will also be responsible for communicating any local course rules that may impact play and provide guidelines for members regarding pace of play, scorecard exchanges, common golfing courtesies and any other significant input that may impact play.
- ❖ All scores by members must be posted.
 - When necessary (i.e. all Wednesday games) scorecards for individual and team games must be reviewed, attested and signed, and turned in to the appropriate individual.
- The Handicap Chair and Executive Board will oversee T- Box assignments:
 - Members over 70 years of age (or will be turning 70 during the current golf season) may play from the #3 tee box, those 80 and older may play from the #4 tees.
 - If a member has a physical issue that may require a possible teeing area change, they may make a request for approval to do so from the Handicap Chair.
- Members are encouraged to resolve any disputes and/or discrepancies in scoring or rules among themselves. If they cannot resolve the issue, they must bring the dispute to the Rules & Course Conditions Committee for final resolution.

Our Services: What we offer that enables us to fulfill our Purpose and achieve our Vision...

- Opportunities Provide multiple opportunities for our members to be engaged in playing the game of golf in various events, outings, competitions, and other venues, as well as hosting occasional social gatherings to promote and foster positive fellowship, a common bond, and fraternity for their joint and mutual benefit.
- Membership While promoting fellowship and camaraderie among our membership we will also strive to make our club enjoyable, accessible, and affordable, thereby achieving a high level of member retention and the ongoing attraction of new members who will uphold our values and traditions. We give our members a voice by holding regular club meetings and keep them aware of all events, schedules, and special announcements or changes.
- Advocate Serve as an advocate and/or intermediary (Executive Board) for the Men's Club in matters pertaining to the overall good will, benefit, affordability, course improvements, and maintaining positive relationship with Lost Tracks Golf Club (owners and management).
- Handicapping & Rules Oversee the appropriate oversight and enforcement (as necessary) of each member's handicap as well as keeping members informed and up-to-date on all USGA/OGA rules, rule changes, and proper interpretations.



EXPECATIONS, GUIDELINES & PRACTICES

Our Expectations of Men's Club Members -

- Members are expected to conduct themselves in such a manner that exemplifies the our Values, supports our Services, and contributes to our Vision and will not bring the name or image of the Men's Club or Lost Tracks Golf Club into disrepute.
- Members are expected to abide by and enforce the USGA Rules of Golf. These rules apply except where local rules prevail.
- To uphold the integrity of the Club at all times every member is expected to post their individual score upon completion of every round in a timely fashion (within 1-2 days). Posting of scores includes those rounds played that are not part of the Club schedule or special outings and events.
- No member shall knowingly submit a false or incorrect scorecard.
- When called upon or appropriate, due to the event, match, or tournament being played, scorecards shall be exchanged between players and/or teams.
- All members are expected and required to abide by conditions set forth in the by-laws. In the event a member violates the purpose and intent of the Men's Club by-laws, he may be suspended or expelled for good cause, including but not limited to: Violations of rules, handicap infractions, and/or any conduct which results in adverse reflection on the Men's Club.
- Suspension or expulsion will be taken by a unanimous vote of the Men's Club Executive Board.
- If a member is suspended or expelled, that member shall forfeit his right to vote and shall be ineligible for all Men's Club activities for a period of time designated by the Executive Board according to the merit of each infraction.
